NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF THE AFFORDABLE HOUSING
SUPPLEMENTARY PLANNING DOCUMENT.

In accordance with Regulation 19 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004, notice is given that Stroud District Council formally adopted its Affordable Housing Supplementary Planning Document on 6th November 2008.

The Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) for Affordable Housing is aimed primarily at developers and landowners. It explains in more detail the different ways that planning applicants can meet Local Plan policies that are designed to include affordable housing within new developments.

Copies of the adopted SPD, the adoption statement and a summary of consultation responses and recommendations are available for inspection at the Customer Service Centre, SDC Council's Offices, Ebley Mill, Stroud, Glos, GL5 4UB, during normal office hours, Monday to Thursday 8.45 a.m. to 5.00 p.m. and Friday 8.45 a.m. to 4.30 p.m.

Any person aggrieved by the SPD may apply to the High Court for permission to apply for Judicial Review of the decision to adopt the statement. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event not later than 3 months from the date of adoption.
