Planning Permission Ref. S.10/1764/COU 26 April 2011 – Land Between Building 66 and Building 104 – Condition 4 - Aston Down

I have contacted you recently about this condition which as you know controls the times when commercial or goods vehicles can enter and leave the site. I have advised you that I have received allegations that the condition has been breached a number of times.

The breaches of the condition are virtually all down to B.Sindle Transport. The reasoning behind this is set out in the material accompanying your current application to vary condition 4. That application and what accompanies it I think confirms that the condition is being breached.

You have mentioned in the past that your staff keep a vehicle movement log. The reports that I have will therefore be verifiable. Please have a look at the log and let me have a list of the dates and times when this shows the condition to have been breached. I would like to compare what is reported to me with what the log shows. The dates reported to me when the condition has been breached are:

04, 06, 18, 22, 24, 29 May

01, 12, 15, 20, 21 June

You will also recall that I confirmed in my letter dated 02 June 2011 that I was not going to pursue immediate action for breaches of the condition. I am attaching a report that was circulated to Members last week. I think it important that this is brought to your attention. I have not sent this to Brian Sindle but I will do if you think it is advisable. I have no objection to you passing it on.
