

### **Canal Project/Cultural Services**

The Council is contributing up to £4,000 towards the National Trailboat Festival. This will be a firework display on the evening of 4 June to celebrate the Queen's Jubilee

### **Museum in the Park**

The Museum Service will be creating a bite-size display at the Museum in the Park to mark this event. There may also be some "workshop" family drop-in type activities; however these have not been planned in any detail. It is not possible to provide projected costs, but everything we do for this will be managed from within our existing museum budget & resources, and will mainly be officer time.

### **Subscription Rooms**

The café bar will be open as normal on a Saturday and we may have some lunchtime bite-size theatre in there. It is not possible to provide projected costs, but everything we do for this will be managed from within our existing budget and resources.

### **Dursley Pool**

We are not planning anything for the Queens Jubilee so zero cost for Dursley Pool.

### **Sports Development**

We will be using existing schemes to celebrate Diamond Jubilee eg: Kapers Summer scheme arts and crafts with jubilee theme, Joint use sports centres gym challenge.

We will be using existing in-house budgets

### **Public Spaces**

We will be creating a Jubilee themed flower carpet bed in Stratford Park approximate cost £1300 and co-ordinating the other summer bedding to reflect the Jubilee colours.

Organising the building and lighting of a Beacon on Selsley Common in conjunction with local farmers/Scout groups and volunteers and perhaps torchlight procession. Should be no cost to Council as wood and labour will be donated free of charge. Some officers time to co-ordinate.

Erection of Bunting and other flags around Stratford Park for duration of Summer, £300 approx

Band on Stratford Park Bandstand £190

Planting of Commemorative tree in Stratford Park £80 and 60 orchard trees(no cost if grant application successful)
