M/02/01/T	7	2.1	<p>General Objections to Strategy Chapter and Paragraphs 2.6.1 to 2.6.4 Modify Chapter 2 of the Plan, Strategy, in accordance with my conclusions above and the suggested text in Appendix 4 to this chapter</p> <p>This effectively results in the deletion of the whole of the current text of Chapter 2 and its substitution by a much more concise text recommended by the Inspector</p>	Modify the text	<p>Agree with most of the reasoning and conclusions of the Inspector at paragraph 2.1 of his report.</p> <p>The major exception is his recommendation that Berkeley should have Principal Settlement status. This is rejected by the Council. Berkeley does not stand out as having significantly better or greater facilities and services than a number of other settlements in the District. It is significantly different to Dursley/Cam as a designated Principal Settlement. Whilst accepting the town does serve a wider area than its immediate boundaries, this is not of such significance that it should be treated differently from other settlements serving a similar role. It is considered that Berkeley does not meet the criteria as required of Principal Settlements in the adopted Structure Plan. Furthermore, the concept of Principal Settlements is not carried forward into the emerging Structure Plan 3rd Alteration.</p> <p>Since the Inspector reported, employment prospects in the vicinity have been damaged by the significant downsizing of the BNFL Magnox operation and Sharpness has not realised its employment potential. There is a significant danger that designation as a principal settlement could lead to unsustainable housing growth poorly related to employment provision.</p>
