STREET NAMEPLATE SPECIFICATION

For Mounting Direct to Smooth Wall

Die pressed sheet aluminium lettered 90mm Kindersley black on non reflective white background with 15mm black margin and radius corners. Drilled stove enamelled and over lacquered.

For Freestanding Erection

Lettering to be 90mm Kindersley. Faceplate to be UV protected 2mm polycarbonate on a 30x150mm black recycled backboard. Powder coated aluminium channel top and bottom to secure faceplate to backboard, mounted on two 75x75x1220mm black recycled plastic posts, morticed to accept the sign. All to be secured using security screws and hidden bolts, capped to achieve a smooth finish.

This Council does not wish to limit developers to a single supplier and any developer wishing to purchase elsewhere is, of course, at liberty to do so. He is required to send his proposed supplier's specification and/or literature to Street Naming and Numbering, Local Land Charges, Stroud District Council, for perusal before endorsing.

Free standing nameplates are to have posts well concreted in above and beneath foot, set for nameplate to be level, the top centred at 1 metre above ground.
