Cutting and relaying slabs around the base of the war memorial using reclaimed stone from the same quarry as the original memorial. Cutting and fitting the slabs and creating a stable base underneath the slabs to prevent future movement. Repair to the front steps of the war memorial caused by weather damage.</p>

Has the project been successful? *Please include any pictures of the project you may have*

Yes. The area around the war memorial had not been constructed with a base layer – the slabs were laid on bare soil. This caused movement which was made worse by vegetation growing between the gaps in the slabs. It has taken time to source the correct stone and to reclaim it. The process of cutting, grading and fitting the new slabs in between the existing slabs, while also constructing a solid foundation, has been painstaking.

The restoration was complete in time for November 2024 Remembrance.
