Thank you for providing Highways England with the opportunity to comment on the Regulation 16 consultation for the draft Cam Neighbourhood Development Plan. We are responsible for operating, maintaining and improving the strategic road network (SRN) which in this case comprises the M5, the mainline of which passes through the plan area.

We are satisfied that the proposed policies within the plan, which do not include proposals to allocate any new development sites, are unlikely to result in development which will adversely impact the SRN and we therefore have no specific comments to make. This does not however prejudice any future responses Highways England may make on site specific applications as they come forward through the planning process, and which will be considered by us on their merits under the appropriate policy at the time.
