Dear Sir/Madam

I would like to register my objection to Stroud District Council's plan for the development known as Wisloe Green. I feel that this plan consists of far too many houses in one place which will have a negative effect on a rural community. It is preferable to prioritise sites at existing larger communities. There will be a huge strain on the existing infrastructure which will create bottlenecks of traffic. There are more jobs in the north of the district and yet this is a large proportion of the houses that are planned here in the south of the area. Dispersal of housing across the whole area is far more preferable.

I object to such a large development being on a green field site and think that the local plan should use brown field sites. As this land is classified as Grade 2 very good agricultural land it should not be considered for development.

This is not a good place for a housing development due to its close proximity to the M5 which is problematic both in terms of noise and air pollution. I do not feel that a band of trees will ease this significantly.
