I wish to express my objections to the proposed development Cambridge for these reasons

The size of the development is far too large for the area and will link 3 Currently separate villages into one.

A report states that the land has been categorised as 3b but this does not reflect the quality of the ground. My house is the only property situated in these fields and I have lived here for over 65 years. The fields that surround my home have always been recognised as highly productive and I can confirm that there is always good crop yield.

It is well recognised that our nearest village, Slimbridge, has been struggling to cope with the current level of sewage produced. These proposals ignore this current issue simply stating that it is a problem for the Sewage company. If there is an overflow then the contamination will affect us all.

The local traffic is already at capacity and this proposal will add up to 3000 more vehicles per day. There is very little local employment so the vast majority of new residents will need to commute. Any study of the current level of traffic does not take into account any of the additional vehicles that will be generated by the many existing and proposed developments that are already being built within 3 miles of this site.

The proposal will destroy an existing green field site and when this is gone it will be lost forever. We live in the countryside by choice but if developments like this are allowed to go ahead future generations will not have that choice.

This area provides a habitat for a huge amount of wildlife which I have been able to observe since I first moved to this home. The proposed development will destroy this habitat and the suggestion that a few ponds and green spaces will redress the balance is nonsense, by the time that has been proven incorrect the existing wildlife will be gone.
