I am writing to object to the large development proposed at Wisloe for the following reasons:

1. The development is far too large and will dwarf existing communities and merge current separate communities into one large sprawl. Dispersal-of housing approach with small developments across the whole district should be approach.
2. There is far too much development in the south of the district (in particular Wisloe and Sharpness) that will cause too much traffic and associated air and noise pollution to that already in existence from the M5 and railway
3. The land proposed is high quality agricultural land and as such is currently used by local farmers. This is not appropriate land to develop on particularly as there is lots of wild life whose habitat is on this land. Brown field sites should be sought. How long have Newport Towers Hotel been derelict. An eyesore and waste of land
4. The area is designated as a rural district and a development of this scale will destroy this along with the current local communities we visit regularly.
5. The area is subject to drainage issues and a flood risk. Totally inappropriate for development
