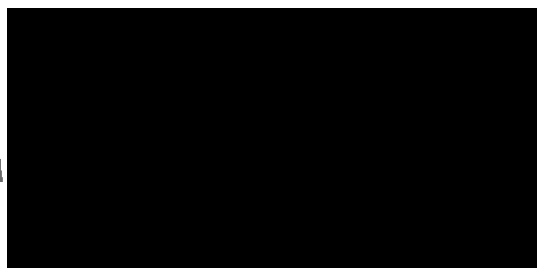

Comments on Stroud district council local plan Leonard Stanley ps16 @ps42. The fields farmed by the Godsell family until sold in 2015 for building. Since then I have complained to the local council from 2018 of all the water running down the field, hits my neighbors fence and runs down my side. The only thing that is stopping the water coming into my garden is the fences. This piece of land has always been very wet and now has got a lot worse. The water has been diverted or has come up in the field from somewhere as water has to go somewhere. Back in November I told Steve Lydon the councilor my concern. Who took my name and address but nobody has come back to me. The land is ps42

I am a very keen cyclist and go out on my bike up to 70 miles per ride. my favourite route is to down the Bath Road to Frocester then on to Cam across the A38 towards Slimbridge around the lanes to Berkley

Then around the lanes to the severn bridge. But in the last 14 months I have been hit off my bike in March Road, and forced into the ditch at Severn Waters. The road from Kings Stanley right through to Cam has become so busy. And the road along Peter Street gets very narrow With nasty bends by the railway bridge. A cyclist was killed here about 5 or 6 years ago. They are building lots more houses by Cam railway station. Which will create the road through to the Stanleys even worse. I try to keep away from main roads when I go cycling But this is getting impossible. In Leonard Stanley there is no proper car parking anywhere, vehicles struggle to get down down March Road and out of Dozule Close. High border lodge on the junction of March Road has not enough parking. [old peoples home] and the Visitors park all around the entrance to Dozule Close. If emergency vehicles require to come down Douzle they would have difficulty due to the continued parking. I asked the local council if they could put yellow lines down, there reply was we can not afford this. Also when the children play football matches on the playing field several teams play at the same time. There is so many cars in Leonard Stanley it is completely clogged. Dozule Close gets clogged up twice a day with parents bringing the children to school. By the school entrance is a turning bay, but the parents use this as a car park and block you in
