Basic Profile

Standish is a small, scattered village spread out over two miles or so, and with 104 households and a population of 284 when its Housing Needs Survey was published in July 2013. Around 60-80 of those residents live at Moreton Hill Care Home.

It is predominantly a farming community and contains the Gloucestershire County Council's largest landholding composed of nine farms over 1,283 acres.
