

Remediation Statement in respect of Contaminated Land

1. The Location and Extent of the Contaminated Land To Which This Remediation Statement Relates.

This Remediation Statement has been prepared in respect of two areas of land (specified below) marked in red on the attached plan (“the Contaminated Land”):

Area 1 – The first 615 metres of the Land measuring from the main road at the France Lynch end of the Land.

Area 2 - The first 209 metres of the Land measuring from the main road at the Eastcombe end of the Land.

The Land lies on the Public Right of Way known as Accommodation Lane, France Lynch, Stroud, Glos (RUPP MCH91).

2. Substance by Reason of Which the Contaminated Land is Contaminated.

Asbestos cement present on, and inlaid into, the surface of the Contaminated Land. The material contains, typically, 15% chrysotile (white asbestos) and, in some areas, 2% crocidolite (blue asbestos).

3. Significant Harm by Reason of Which the Contaminated Land is so Contaminated.

Inhalation by both human beings and owned animals of asbestos fibres released to atmosphere.

4. Remediation Actions.

The following remediation actions have been taken to seal the asbestos cement present on the Land under a suitably hard-wearing surface:

1. Grass between the wheel tracks on the Contaminated Land was killed.
2. Wheel tracks and pot-holes on the Contaminated Land were regulated using Type 1 Sub Base.
3. The Contaminated Land was overlain with a nominal 55mm of 20mm dense limestone basecourse.

The above remediation actions were carried out under the orders of Stroud District Council, Ebley Mill, Stroud, Glos, GL5 4UB. The contractor chosen to carry out the

work was Ringway Highway Services Limited, Shepherd Road, Cole Avenue,
Gloucester, GL2 5HA.

The remediation works were carried out between the dates 18th July, 2001 and 31st
July, 2001.
