OUTCOME OF HEARING

REPRESENTATIONS MADE BY RESPONSIBLE AUTHORITIES

No representations were received from responsible authorities.

OTHER REPRESENTATIONS

There was one representation received against the application, from the proprietor of the adjoining bird park. The representation set out concerns relating to littering and anti-social behaviour being exacerbated by sales of alcohol on the site as well as the risks to children visiting the site whilst alcohol is being sold. The representor did not attend the hearing.

The Panel heard from the Applicant, another member of staff from the Premises and a representative of the Community Payback Scheme with which the Premises is associated.

DECISION

The Panel took into account the comments made on behalf of the Applicant and the written representation received. The Panel also considered the four licensing objectives set out in the Licensing Act 2003 as well as the statutory guidance issued in accordance with that act and the Council's Licensing Policy.

Having regard to all of the above, the Panel decided that the carrying on of the licensable activities set out in the Application would not present any credible or substantive risks when considered against the aforementioned licensing objectives and would not be in conflict with the Council's Licensing Policy.

Accordingly, the Panel decided to **GRANT** a licence in the terms applied for.

MANDATORY CONDITIONS

The licence will also be subject to the conditions set out in Section 19 and elsewhere in the Licensing Act 2003.
