- Pride in helping to improve your neighbours' satisfaction with their surroundings

- Basic training on conducting checks, identifying and reporting findings
- Informal in-person information sessions or Information pack (whichever is preferable)
- On-going support from Stroud District Council colleagues
- Travel expenses to meetings if required, in line with our Expenses & Incentives Policy

- Able to dedicate around 30 minutes a week to carry out inspections, though this can be more or less frequent depending on what feels appropriate for the area or the weather.
- We are looking for individuals who can provide detailed and informative reports, including photos where possible, to improve the quality of our services.
