How many responses have been received?</p>	<p>The responses to the consultation are still being analysed, there are 1080 responses from individuals or organisations. We have also received petitions from Nailsworth with 576 signatures and Wotton with 1061 signatures.</p>

Please give details of meetings arranged by officers, as part of the consultation process, with representative bodies, i.e town Councils, When and where?</p>	<p>All Town and Parish Councils have been sent a consultation email.</p> <p>There have been meetings held with Cainscross and Minchinhampton Parish Councils and Nailsworth, Dursley Wotton Stroud and Stonehouse Town Councils as detailed in the table below. The Head of Community Services is trained as a Hate Crime Champion and has close links with Gloucestershire Constabulary Hate Crime Co-ordinator.</p>
