Active for Life Equipment Loan Scheme

About the Active for Life Equipment

The Active for Life adapted sports equipment can be used to increased Mobility, coordination, mental health, wellbeing and increased social activity. This might be particular helpful in care settings or community groups aimed at older people. All of the equipment can be used sitting or standing and it easy to set up.

Our Service

Equipment should be collected from Stroud District Council, Ebley Mill. There is a selection of equipment packs available and more than one can be hired at a time for a £20 returnable cheque deposit per equipment pack. The maximum loan period is 8 weeks.

Provided with the equipment are rules and games ideas.

5 Ways to Wellbeing



Introduce these five simple habits into your life and feel the benefit.

Our Equipment Packs



Boccia (10 sets)

A game of precision, where the players aim at placing their balls as close to the jack (the white target ball) as possible)



New Age Bowls (12 sets)

The game is played in the same way as the traditional game of bowls - and to make this true to life the bowls contain a genuine bias similar to normal bowls.



Scoring Wedge (12 wedges)

The Wedge is used by delivering 4 red and 4 blue bowls or balls to the high score wedge. When this is completed count the score of both players.

The player with the highest score wins a point for that end.

Term and Conditions of Loan

- Equipment will be loaned subject to completion of the attached form.
- At all times the equipment is the property of Stroud District Council (SDC) and we reserve the right to collect the equipment at any time.
- The return of equipment can be requested by SDC if it is not being utilised as intended.
- The person hiring the equipment must be present and ensure adequate supervision levels of the use of equipment at all times and ensure its safe use.
- The equipment must be returned in its original condition with all parts of the equipment pack present. If the set is returned incomplete or damaged the deposit will not be returned. Additional costs may also be incurred.
- Any vandalism or wilful damage to the equipment; or if the equipment is stolen whilst in possession of the hirer, must be paid for in full by the hirer.
- SDC takes no responsibility or liability for any injury or accident that may occur whilst using the Active for Life equipment.
- It is the responsibility of the hirer to ensure they have their own correct and up to date insurance in place and that they have conducted robust risk assessments to run the activities. This is not the responsibility of SDC.
- The organisation is fully responsible for the equipment for the duration of the loan period and must not allow anyone to borrow it. Sub-letting is not permitted.
- Equipment will be loaned on an availability basis. You may be put on a waiting list if equipment is unavailable.
- Equipment can be collected/returned at a time agreed by SDC. Organisations are responsible for the equipment up until it is returned to SDC in person.
- All bookings, collections and returns will be made during normal SDC working hours (Mon– Fri 9am-3pm).
- On return of the equipment, organisations must complete the evaluation form that is included in the equipment pack.
