

Take a Stand® Annual Project Report

Stroud 2024/2025

Background

Life Cycle have been proud to administer the Take a Stand scheme in Stroud this year. Our new relationship shows the commitment of the council to encourage sustainable travel in the region.

The parameters of the scheme are for up to up to 5 bolt down or sink in stands to be supplied and installed at small business locations or community groups, to encourage and support active travel.

Delivery of this year's Project:

In March 2024 you awarded us brand new funding, ready for the new financial year, to cover the cost of **100** 'Sheffield' cycle stands, which we allocated over approx. 8 months. We were then delighted to receive additional funding for a further **50** stands.

Feedback

All businesses participating in the scheme are invited to complete a feedback survey 3 months after installation which provides useful information.

From the organisations that have been surveyed and who have replied so far:

- o they all confirmed the stands "improved bike security"
- o they all said the stands are already being used several times a week or daily
- with the levels of cycling increasing
- and comments about the service included "Everything was really straightforward and friendly." & "Very quick and efficient service."

The Future

We are so pleased to have just received funding for a further 50 stands and, as I already have a waiting list, I've started work on that.

More marketing, including a case study, is being worked on so that we can get the message to even more areas of Stroud and get these new stands installed as quickly as we can.

It's great having such a positive working relationship with you and we hope that this continues for many years to come.
