Stroud District Council has commenced a Community Governance Review for the following areas:

The purpose of the review is to enable the Council to consider what changes, if any, are needed to parish arrangements. Any recommendations arising from the review will seek to ensure that community governance remains effective, convenient and reflects the identity and interests of local communities.

The Council is now conducting the first phase of consultation and is inviting residents and interested organisations from the areas listed above to submit their views as part of the public consultation. The Council welcomes representations from any person or organisation who may wish to comment on the existing arrangements in their local area or make proposals on any aspect of the matters covered by the review that would reflect better community governance.

Responses for the first phase of consultation may be submitted between Friday 17 July and Wednesday 9 September 2026.
