

STROUD DISTRICT COUNCIL (OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION)

ORDER 2010 (AS AMENDED) VARIATION ORDER No. 1 2026

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Stroud District Council (“the Council”) **HAS MADE** an Order under Sections 32 and 35 of and under Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers with the consent of Gloucestershire County Council in accordance with Section 39(3) of the Act and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.
2. The Order which came into effect on 6 February 2026 may be cited as ‘Stroud District Council (Off Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2010 (as amended) Variation Order No. 1 2026’ and relates to High Street Car Park, Stonehouse Gloucestershire (Long and Short stay) (“the car park”).
3. The purpose of the Order is to introduce a requirement to obtain and affix to a vehicle a zero value ticket for the long stay area of the car park and reduce the maximum time for long stay parking from 23 hours to 9 hours. Hours of operation for the short stay area of the car park is also to be reduced from all hours to 8 a.m. to 6 p.m.
4. The Order may be inspected within the next six weeks by prior appointment (telephone no. 01453 766321) at the Reception of Stroud District Council Ebley Mill Ebley Wharf Stroud Glos GL5 4UB during normal working hours or online at www.stroud.gov.uk
5. Any person who wishes to question the validity of this Order or any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act on any ground that any requirement of the Act or any instrument made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to this Order may within six weeks from the date of this Notice make application to the High Court.
