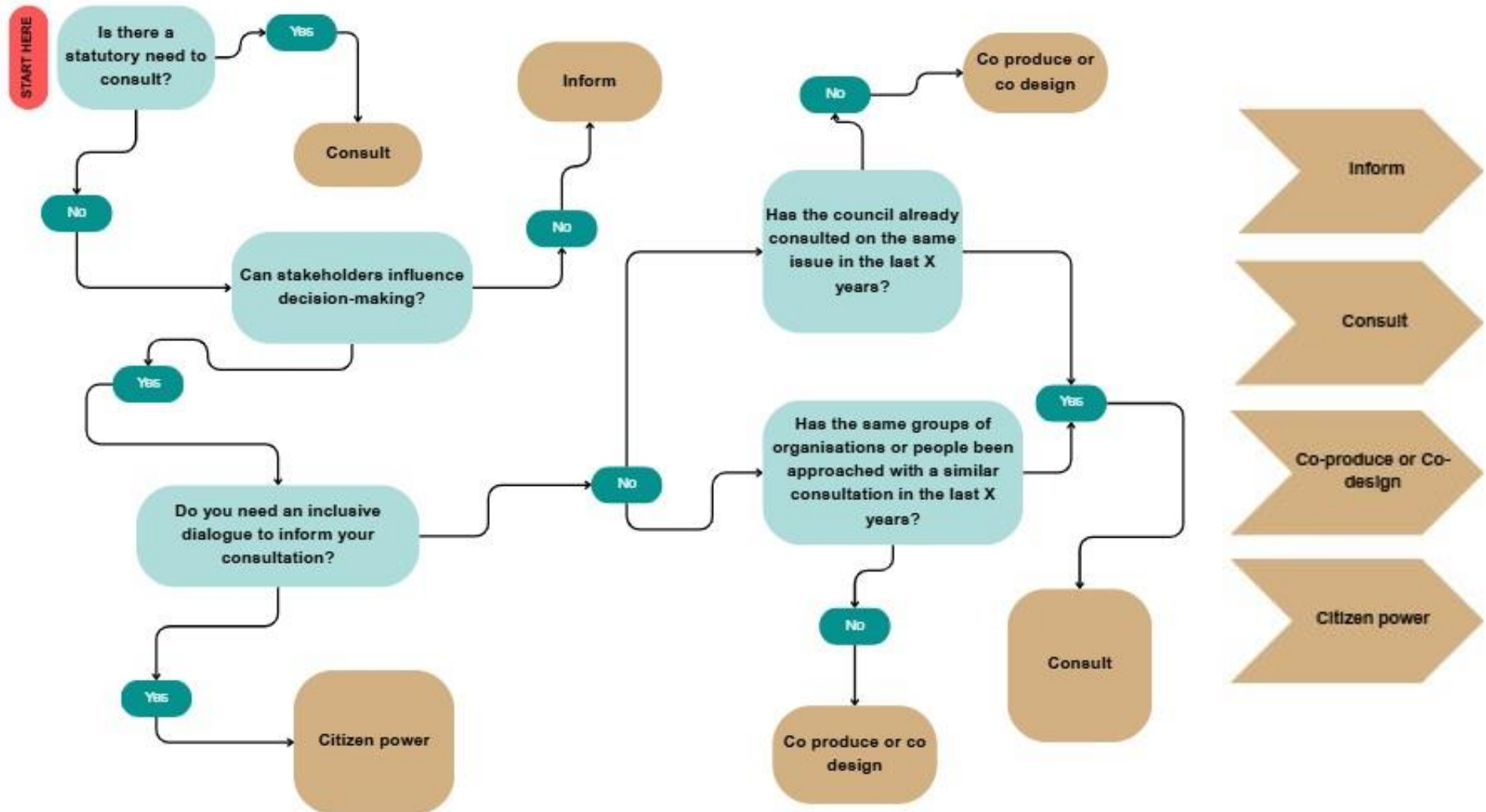
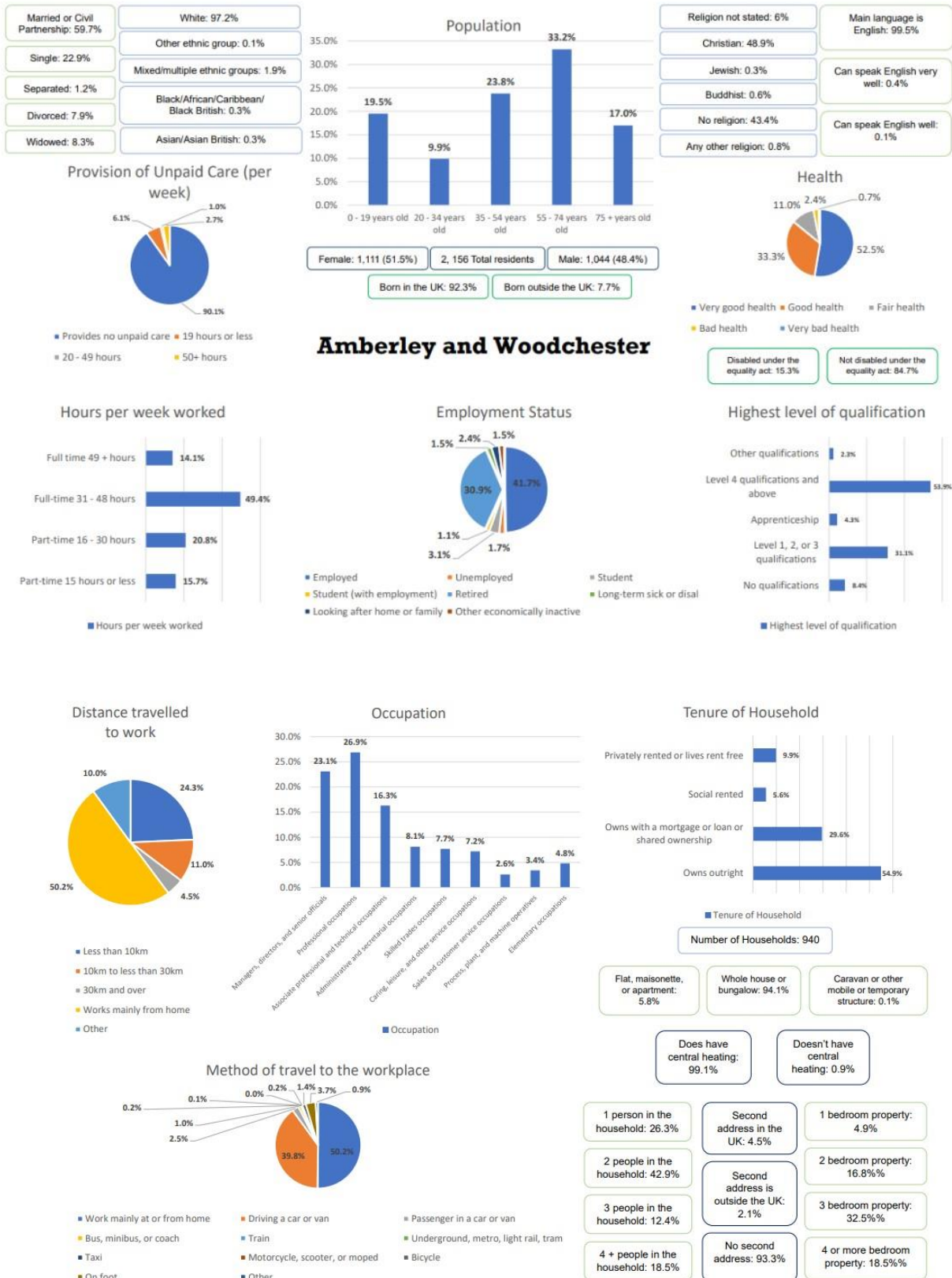


Flow Chart for Officers

Standardised Demographic Questions

Standardised Demographic Questions

As a Council, we need to ensure that we are using a standardised set of demographic questions and answer options so that information gathered is consistent and comparable across questionnaires. Using varied or different categories or answer options for respondents to select over multiple different consultations can cause inconsistencies in the data.

You should **only** ask demographic questions when **necessary**. This document details the core question set. Further demographic data can be collected if it is required for the consultation. Guidance on secondary demographic questions will be provided.
