<p>Project Name: Refurbishment of footways around the Playing Field</p> <p>Project Location: Hardwicke – Footways bordering playing fields leading to school and residential areas. Green Lane Hardwicke</p>
<p>Brief Description:</p> <p>The footways surrounding the playing field lead to the local primary school and to residential areas. Over the years theses paths have become full of potholes and less safe to walk on. Due to the good working relationship with the County Council's Area Highways Manager we were able to identify a joint project to resurface a large area of footway. The Parish Council contributed £5,000 of its CIL money to the project and was able to get further support from County Council Services</p> <p>Has the project been successful?</p> <p>Very, and well received by residents, it has also helped encourage more people to safely walk to school</p>

Project Name: Replacement of Toilets for Hardwicke Rangers Football Club
 Project Location: The Close, Green Lane Hardwicke

Brief Description:

Hardwicke Rangers Football Club provides coaching and football to around 400 young people. There are a number of teams from ages 4 to 16 and have a wide membership for girls and boys. Over the years the toilet facilities have become inadequate and in poor condition. The Club approached the Parish Council for support and the Council agreed to fund the project for a replacement toilet facility; this was done using money from CIL and from the Parish Council budget.

The new toilets provide separate facilities for girls and boys and importantly, provide accessible facilities for young people with a disability.

Has the project been successful?

Very successful and provided a much needed and updated facility

Amount of CIL spent on the project: £3800
