Randwick Parish Council has worked with specialist consultants to produce a Draft CAS, which describes the character and historic significance of the conservation area and sets out a series of management proposals and design guidelines to help ensure the conservation area is conserved and enhanced.

Following consultation, Stroud District Council will consider adopting the document as Supplementary Planning Advice (SPA), to help inform planning decisions and steer the application of **Local Plan policies** within the conservation area.
