I live in Painswick, and the local housing plan has not changed in the 38 years we have lived here. We live on Stroud rd. on the corner of Kingsmill lane, and have an acre of garden. part of it is below our house and fronts on to Kingsmill lane, possibly 1/3 of an acre bounded by the Washwell stream on one side and mature trees on the other [which I would not want to see taken down] My husband mows it in the summer, but otherwise it is of very little use to us. When I see huge houses built in the center of the village on tiny plots, I wonder why we could not apply for planning permission [we have not tried] just because it is a short way down the road, and it is not a field. Is this likely to be forever?
