***This premises review submission regards the significant and ongoing breaches over a long period by the Premises Licence Holder of the Fleece Inn, Hillesley Community Pub Ltd and the Designated Premises Supervisor (and landlady) [REDACTED] of the Licensing Objective 'The prevention of crime and disorder'.***

***Based on the content, assertions made and supported by significant evidence available and submitted to the police etc, from the attached documentation it is clear that there have been ongoing and multiple breaches of the Licensing Act 2003 regarding the 'Prevention of crime and disorder' with the situations being very poorly managed throughout with the Premises Licence Holder and the Designated Premises Supervisor displaying no regard for the law or the adverse and damaging consequences of their failure to adhere to a core Licencing objective.***

***The Licencing Act 2003 specifies a range of options available regarding the licence – in the circumstances as covered in the attached document, the firmest possible action permissible under the Act based on the case and facts is respectfully requested.***

***Based upon mine and the experiences of others over the past nearly two years, I believe this is required if the Fleece Inn is ever going to comply with the Licensing Act objective 'Prevention of Crime and Disorder'.***


