Clubhouse - Indoors

Sale of Alcohol -On and Off Sales	Friday and Saturday 11:00 to 00:30 Sunday to Thursday 11:00 to 23:00
Films	Every Day 11:30 to 00:00
Live Music*	Friday to Saturday 23:00 to 00:30
Recorded Music*	Friday and Saturday 23:00 to 00:30
Late Night Refreshment	Friday and Saturday 23:00 to 00:30

*Under the Live and Recorded Music exemptions, live and recorded music is automatically permitted during the times that on sale of alcohol are permitted provided it is no later than 23:00. Live and recorded music after 23:00 must be included on the licence.

Club House Non- standard Hours

Permitted Hours for the Supply of Alcohol on New Years Eve, Christmas Eve and Recognised Bank Holidays and Bank Holiday Weekends are 11.00 - 0100

Club House Pitch, Cricket Pitch, Paddock, Training Ground and New Pitch

Supply by retail of Alcohol Every Day 11:00 to 21:30

Top Pitch

Supply by retail of Alcohol Friday to Sunday 11:00 to 18:00

The opening hours of the Club and Outside areas

Clubhouse Friday and Saturday 11:00 to 01:00
Sunday to Thursday 11:00 to 23:30

Club House Pitch, Cricket Pitch, Paddock, Training Ground and New Pitch
Every Day 11:00 to 22:00

Top Pitch Friday to Sunday 11:00 to 18:30

Volunteered Conditions to go on Premises Licence – these replicate conditions on the Current Club Premises Certificate

1. Committee Member and/or responsible adult to be present during functions
Committee Members and/or responsible adult nominated by the Club Committee will always be present when functions with regulated entertainment are being held and shall be familiar with all licence conditions.
2. Committee Members/Staff Training
All Committee Members/Staff that undertake the supply of alcohol shall receive appropriate training in relation to preventing underage sales, proxy sales and drunk sales, before being allowed to supply any alcohol. Refresher training shall be carried out at least once every year and documented within the training records. Training records shall be available at the premises for inspection by police or authorised officers of the licensing authority upon reasonable request.
3. Incident Log
An incident log (either written or electronic form) shall be kept and maintained on the premises. The log will include:
 - a. All crime reported to the Club
 - b. All ejections of patrons
 - c. Any incidents of disorder
 - d. Any noise complaints received
 - e. Any refusals of supply of alcohol

The log will also include the date, time and name of the Committee Member/Staff making the record, along with the details of the incident, any action taken and will be made available to police or authorised officers of the licensing authority upon reasonable request.
4. Maximum Occupancy
Maximum occupancy within the Club - 150 - (One Hundred and Fifty)
5. Doors and Windows
When the licensable activities of Live and Recorded music are taking place all external doors and windows will be closed except for access and egress
6. Children
Children are not permitted to the Club if there is entertainment of an adult nature
7. Televised Sporting Events
All licensable activities are permitted in the Club House on occasions where there is the broadcast of live televised sporting events of national and international interest which occur outside normal permitted hours. On such occasions the Club will give notice in writing to the police at least 7 working days before the event which will include the details of the event and the proposed hours to be open for licensable activities. If the police give the club a written notice that the event should not go ahead on the grounds of crime and disorder then the event will not take place.

8 Plastic Containers at sporting events

When sporting events take place alcoholic and soft drinks will be served in plastic containers

CONDITIONS RELATING TO THE CLUB HOUSE

1 Closed Door Policy

On Fridays and Saturdays, the club shall operate a closed-door policy with no admission to new patrons after 23:30 hours.

2 Closing Time

The club must be cleared of patrons and closed no later than thirty minutes after the end of retail sale of alcohol.

3 Signage

There shall at all times be displayed at each and every exit from the club building, the car park and the driveway, in a prominent visible location, easily accessible and readable by all patrons at least one written notice of a minimum of A4 size that contains details requesting the public to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and area quietly and to take their litter home.
